Natalie Passmore cross country clinic

Once again, Natalie ran a super cross country clinic at Pontispool on 2 April for some of our members. It was a fantastic day and the groups of four had an hour and a half each on the course to get them ready for the season ahead.

Health and safety

It was great to see so many of you out on the cross-country course on the first weekend in April and, with Camps fast approaching, please check your hats, back protectors and tack...

- Please check that your hat meets one of the following standards: PAS 015:1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040:2014-12, ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001) or AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards. If your hat does not meet one of these standards, please replace it with one that does.
- As the cross country season is now underway, please ensure that if you are riding cross country at a Club event, you wear a top with sleeves that at least cover the top of your arms down to almost your elbows, preferably further, as well as your body protector, Level 3 (purple label) 2000 or 2009.
- Please check the stitching on your tack and don't neglect your metal items – members of the committee have frighteningly broken a stirrup whilst eventing and a bit in the show jumping ring. If something is wearing thin, please replace it!
- If you are unfortunate enough to have a fall at one of our events or clinics, please make sure you remember to complete an accident form with the instructor or organiser before you leave.

If you would like to raise any H&S issues, please let one of the committee know.

Camps

As you are reading this newsletter, more than 30 of our members are excitedly getting ready to attend our Spring Camp at Stockland Lovell on 5-7 May. Summer Camp is currently full but please contact Elaine if you want to go on the waiting list. If you've missed out on this opportunity so far this year, you could attend our Autumn Camp in September (entry form attached).

Don't leave it until the last minute!

Sadly, we had to cancel several events last year due to lack of entries and then had lots of reply slips arrive after we had cancelled instructor and venue. 3. Ask the Secretary at the event to confirm your placing with their signature.
4. Post your completed points card back to BRC HQ **by the 7th of the following month.**

No refunds without a vet's certificate.

If you are no longer able to attend a clinic or competition, please also phone and tell us. Sometimes we can fill your slot with someone from a waiting list and we may be able to refund your money if we can do this. We worry about whether you are okay if you simply don't turn up too – please let us know if you will not be coming.

RIDING HATS must be worn at all times and harnesses properly adjusted & fastened.

Hats should meet one of the following standards:

PAS 015:1998 or 2011

VG1 01.040:2014-12

ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001)

AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards

BACK PROTECTORS Level 3 (purple label) 2000 or 2009 are strongly recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country, and a **MEDICAL ARM BAND** is advised for all riders.

If you are in any doubt about whether your clinic or competition will go ahead due to adverse weather conditions, etc, please contact the organiser to check.

1. Rosettes to 6th place.
2. Each team to be made up of 3 riders.
3. There will be 3 rounds, 2'3", 2'6" and 2'9".
4. 1 rider from each team will jump at each height.
5. There will be a 30 minute break while the course is changed, then the riders will all jump again.
6. In the event of a tie, at this stage then a jump-off against the clock will take place over a 2' 9" course.
7. Any rider from each team may be nominated to jump in the jump-off.
8. Penalties will be incurred as follows:
 - 4 faults for a fence down,
 - 4 faults for each refusal,
 - no eliminations - just penalties added.
9. The only round to be timed will be the final jump-off.
10. Any horse and rider may only be in any team once, however any horse may be used by two riders across two teams and any rider may compete in two different teams as long as they ride two different horses.

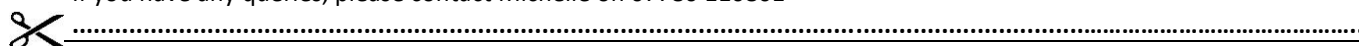
