GDPR

South Devon Riding Club holds personal data on its members. Maintaining your trust and confidence is a high priority. In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which comes into effect in May 2018, we require your consent to store and share this information when and where relevant. As you've all recently filled a membership form in with your details, we assume that you're happy for us to hold them so that we can communicate with you. Health and safety

After a wet start to the year, we hope that you are all back out on the cross-country courses now and, with Camps fast approaching, please check your hats, back protectors and tack...

- Please check that your hat meets one of the following standards: PAS 015:1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040:2014-12, ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001) or AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards. If your hat does not meet one of these standards, please replace it with one that does.
- As the cross country season is now underway, please ensure that if you are riding cross country at a Club event, you wear a top with sleeves that at least cover the top of your arms down to almost your elbows, preferably further, as well as your body protector, Level 3 (purple label) 2000 or 2009.
- Please check the stitching on your tack and don't neglect your metal items – members of the committee have frighteningly broken a stirrup whilst eventing and a bit in the show jumping ring. If something is wearing thin, please replace it!
- If you are unfortunate enough to have a fall at one of our events or clinics, please make sure you remember to complete an accident form with the instructor or organiser before you leave.

If you would like to raise any H&S issues, please let one of the committee know.

SDRC managed to finish 10th as a team with Karen Long and Pheonix jumping 3 fantastic clear rounds and finishing an amazing 6th individually! The Dressage Team of Elaine Cleverdon (E50), Becky Wright (N30), Michelle Harris (N24) and Alexis Marler (P14) put up a good fight against stiff competition, with some lovely tests but unfortunately was not placed. Helen Cobbold riding Bourne on the Up competed in the Prelim 14 class as an individual and came 8th! Well done to all competitors and thank you to everyone who travelled to help and support!

ALL CLINICS close for entries and withdrawals one week before the clinic.
No refunds without a vet's certificate.

RIDING HATS must be worn at all times and harnesses properly adjusted & fastened.

Hats should meet one of the following standards:

- PAS 015:1998 or 2011
- VG1 01.040:2014-12
- ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001)
- AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards

From 1 January 2018, British Riding Clubs, British Eventing and The Pony Club have joined together to unify riding hat standards across all three member bodies and a new aqua coloured tag will mean that multiple tags will no longer be necessary.

BACK PROTECTORS Level 3 (purple label) 2009 are strongly recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country, and a MEDICAL ARM BAND is advised for all riders.

If you are no longer able to attend a clinic or competition, please also phone and tell us. Sometimes we can fill your slot with someone from a waiting list and we may be able to refund your money if we can do this. We worry about whether you are okay if you simply don't turn up too – please let us know if you will not be coming.

If you are in any doubt about whether your clinic or competition will go ahead due to adverse weather conditions, etc, please contact the organiser to check.

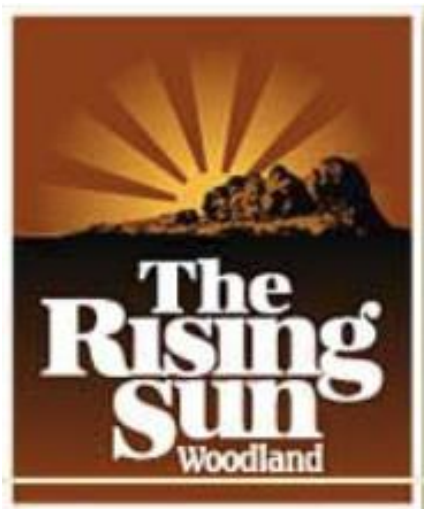
