General information

ALL CLINICS close for entries and withdrawals one week before the clinic.
No refunds without a vet's certificate.

RIDING HATS must be worn at all times and harnesses properly adjusted & fastened.

Hats should meet one of the following standards: PAS 015:1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040:2014-12, ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001), AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards

From 1 January 2018, British Riding Clubs, British Eventing and The Pony Club have joined together to unify riding hat standards across all three member bodies and a new aqua coloured tag will mean that multiple tags will no longer be necessary.

BACK PROTECTORS Level 3 (purple label) 2009 are strongly recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country, and a MEDICAL ARM BAND is advised for all riders.

If you are no longer able to attend a clinic or competition, please also phone and tell us. Sometimes we can fill your slot with someone from a waiting list and we may be able to refund your money if we can do this. We worry about whether you are okay if you simply don't turn up too – please let us know if you will not be coming.

If you are in any doubt about whether your clinic or competition will go ahead due to adverse weather conditions, etc, please contact the organiser to check.
