Health and safety

Some members are still “forgetting” to put their date of birth on their entry slips. If we have to send you to hospital, the minimum information asked for by the emergency services is your name and date of birth. We promise we will not laugh at your age or share this information around but we really need this information please, just in case! If your date of birth is not on your entry slip, your entry may be refused.

Please also be aware that, in the event of a more serious accident, your emergency contact will be contacted and the care of you and your horse will be given back to that person. Please make sure that the person you write down is aware of their responsibility and, if they are not part of your family or capable of dealing with your horse, they know how to contact your family and someone who could take your horse home.

If you are unfortunate enough to have a fall at one of our events or clinics, please make sure you remember to complete an accident form with the instructor or organiser before you leave.

If you would like to raise any H&S issues, please let one of the committee know.

Grassroots league

Points can be gained when competing at BRC Club organised competitions. It's so simple, just follow these easy steps.

2. Compete at any Dressage (Intro and Prelim level) or showjumping (60cm & 70cm) BRC Club organised competition or Redpost.
3. Ask the Secretary at the event to confirm your placing with their signature.
4. Post your completed points card back to BRC HQ **by the 7th of the following month.**

Teams

Congratulations to Elaine Cleverdon and Broadstone Dot.com who did a lovely test and came 4th in the Area Dressage to Music Qualifier in May.

The Area Horse Trials was, as always, full of highs and lows, with a team of four competing at both 80cm and 90cm and an individual at 80cm. It was a thoroughly exciting and exhausting day for all of us! The 90 team, were all in the top ten; Adam Scott, 9th on Benview Rose, Jenna Glynn, 7th on The General Maximus, Michelle Harris, 2nd on Saint Elina and Karen Long, 7th on Pheonix. The team came 2nd and so narrowly missed qualifying for the National Finals as only the winning team went through. The 80 team also had some good placings; Anna Picknett on Mo Cara Rua, Lauren Picknett on True Colours V, Alexis Marler, 2nd on Valleybrook Leonardo and Becky Wright, 3rd on Mustang Sally. This team was one of 4 teams tying for first place so placings were decided on minor rules which put us disappointingly in 3rd place, again narrowly missed qualifying for the National Finals. Harriett Billingham on Hunros Talisman also put in a great individual performance and thoroughly enjoyed their first horse trials.

We would have liked to enter the very oversubscribed Blenheim Palace Riding Clubs Eventers' Challenge in September but sadly, we didn't have enough entries to enter a team. Hopefully we will have more interest again next year. We also had no entries for the Summer Area Dressage and only one for the Summer Show Jumping, who had to withdraw on the day.

ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001)

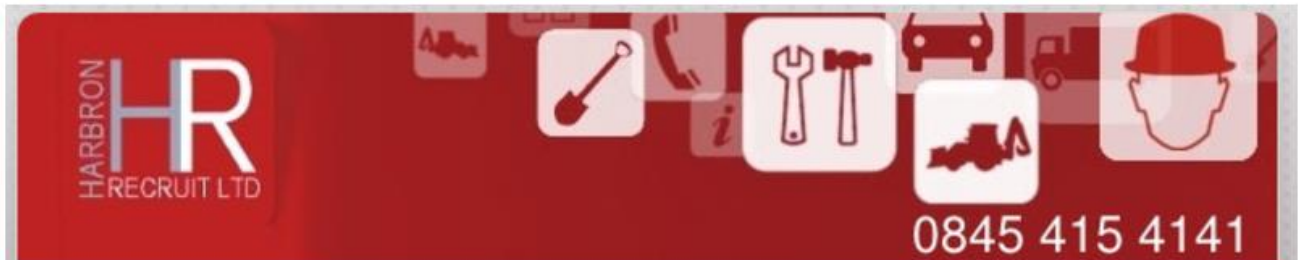
AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards
