Well done to the winners of our annual awards: Annie Nathan (Alison Abbey), Shelagh Williams (Andrew Lovell), Michelle Head (Emily Farleigh), our Volunteers of the Year, Clare Mann and Mimi Beer, and a special achievement award for Megan Wood and her lovely horse, Harvey, for qualifying for 3 National Finals this year! There were also special thanks to Gary Milton and Andy Wright for running the cross country start, finish and timing at the Area Horse Trials, and Gary also judged all day at the Three Phase Day. Special rosettes were also presented to the 16 members who had represented the Club at National Finals this year. Well done to all those who won prizes in the raffle and many thanks to all the generous organisations and people who donated them including Redpost Equestrian, Bicton College and Bicton Arena. A total of £208 was donated to the Air Ambulance. Following requests at the AGM for online entries, we will now be trialling Equo Events for the Spring Camp and gradually extending this to some of our clinics.

## **Winter Dressage series**

Due to the ongoing improvements at the Mare & Foal Sanctuary, unfortunately we have had to cancel all 3 of the Winter Dressage series. We have searched for other suitable venues to use in the meantime but have not been able to organise replacement competitions. Please bear with us – normal service will be resumed as soon as possible!

## **2019**

As usual, we would like to provide some opportunities to get out on the cross country courses at the start of the season, so we have booked Andrew Lovell at Pontispool in March and Nell Candelaria at Poltmore Park in April. Nell's session will concentrate on developing the confidence of horse and rider in a supportive environment, with cross country jumps ranging from very small up to 85cm, whilst Andrew's clinic will be more suitable for horses and riders who want to jump 80cm or more.

We would like to continue with some of our clinics as the work at Coombe Park continues so we have planned to have Emily's clinics in March, April and May in the outdoor arena, just in case the work is still going on. Andrew Lovell's clinics will also continue at Coombe Park in the outdoor arena until the work is complete. Andrew's sessions have been extended to 45 minutes and we had done our best to keep the price competitive for these very popular and beneficial clinics. We are constantly reviewing our clinic locations for competitiveness and facilities to bring you the best available instructors at the most suitable venues. This includes a commitment to lower clinic prices if we are able to in the future if different venues and facilities become available.

## **Camps**

With three camps to choose from in 2019, we are sure we have something for everyone. Camps are a fantastic way to get to know us better whilst improving your riding and your relationship with your horse. We always have a lot of fun and make new friends. We'd love you to join us but these are sure to fill up fast! The booking forms for Spring and Summer Camps are at the end of this newsletter. ## **Volunteers**

2019 sees the second year of the league for our BRC volunteers, including non-members! The league runs from January to December 2019, with completed monthly points cards to be returned to BRC by the 7<sup>th</sup> of the next month. Volunteers must download a points card from <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-volunteers/volunteers-league>. Volunteers simply need to fill out the details on the card and have their card signed by the secretary to confirm the number of hours they volunteered for and the role they undertook.

## **Grassroots**

British Riding Clubs runs a Grassroots league for members who wish to take part in dressage (Walk and Trot and Prelim Level) and showjumping (60cms and 70cms) at BRC Club organised competitions. Show jumping classes at Redpost may also be used. The league runs from January to October, with completed monthly score cards to be returned to BRC by the 7<sup>th</sup> of the next month. Points will be awarded according to your place in the class, from 6 points for 1st place to 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> place. Competitors must download a score card from <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-championships/brc-points-league> then get this signed by the Secretary should they be placed in the top 6 at any qualifying competition. The Secretary's signature must be completed on the day of competition.

Let's see if we can get some South Devon members in the top ten nationally!

## **Teams**

It's been a very busy year for the Club with so many members competing at our Area qualifiers, and also qualifying to represent Area 19 at the national finals in so many events!

November saw the first ever Arena Eventing Qualifier, which was held at Bicton Arena and very kindly hosted and shared with us by Area 12. With massive over-subscription, it was run over two days instead of the one planned, and team members were incredibly patient and co-operative as Area 12 tried to organise the event to enable everyone who had entered to compete. 27 of our members represented us in 70cm to 1m classes. On the Saturday, most of the 70 and 80cm arena was under water but by Sunday, there was just an unplanned lake at one end! It was one of those weekends where you rush between arenas in order to watch everyone go and there were multiple highs and lows. When the final scores were calculated, we posted ten top 10 placings, Clare Mann and Murphy qualified for Nationals at 70cm, along with one of the 90 teams – congratulations to all of you!

### General information

ALL CLINICS close for entries and withdrawals one week before the clinic.  
No refunds without a vet's certificate.

RIDING HATS must be worn at all times and harnesses properly adjusted & fastened.  
Hats should meet one of the following standards: PAS 015:1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040:2014-12, ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards (SNELL E2001), AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards

From 1 January 2018, British Riding Clubs, British Eventing and The Pony Club have joined together to unify riding hat standards across all three member bodies and a new aqua coloured tag will mean that multiple tags will no longer be necessary.

BACK PROTECTORS Level 3 (purple label) 2009 are strongly recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country, and a MEDICAL ARM BAND is advised for all riders.

If you are no longer able to attend a clinic or competition, please also phone and tell us. Sometimes we can fill your slot with someone from a waiting list and we may be able to refund your money if we can do this. We worry about whether you are okay if you simply don't turn up too – please let us know if you will not be coming.

If you are in any doubt about whether your clinic or competition will go ahead due to adverse weather conditions, etc, please contact the organiser to check.

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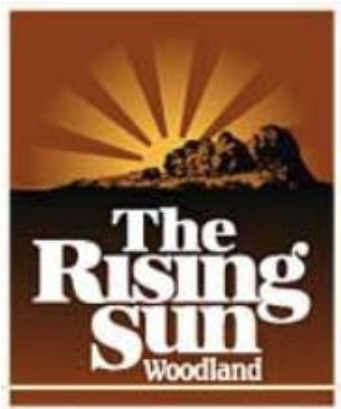

# SPRING CAMP



Friday 3 to Sunday 5 May 2019

At Stockland Lovell

For those who have not been to camp before, here is a quick summary of events: Arrive Friday and go for a hack around the grounds of Stockland Lovell. Then, on both Saturday and Sunday, you will have two lessons per day, one in the morning, and one in the afternoon. The emphasis of the Camp is to have fun and we are able to cater for all levels of rider, from beginner to those who are competing on a regular basis. In the evenings, we just have fun! On a practical note, your horse does need to be fit to make the most of your time at Camp. You will also need to be absolutely sure that you have your passport and valid vaccination card with you. Stockland Lovell states that if members fail to produce this when asked, they will not be allowed to have their horse on the premises. You will also need to make sure that you have a body protector and medical armband for the cross country. Armbands are available from Redpost, Leonard Coombe or online at British Eventing.

The total cost of the Camp is £255, **please be aware late entry increases to £270**. The price includes accommodation for you and your horse, including hay and bedding, use of all the facilities, your food and your tuition. Non-riders are welcome to attend at a cost of £126. This Camp is strictly for members only. Places are first come first served.
