**70 indoor SJ** – this was a new competition and held on 17 November but unfortunately we missed it completely as the emailed schedule was titled "Junior Qualifier" so I didn't even open it. I have had a long discussion with Area Rep about this!

**Area Talk** by Richard Waygood titled 'one team' on Saturday, 1 February 2020. Richard is our World Class Performance Manager for British Eventing and will give us an insight into how we are so successful on a National Scale and our Olympic preparations. This is run alongside British Riding Clubs Area 19 and details and booking is available from their website: Tickets cost £5. I understand that there is also **Area subsidised training**: Richard Waygood Area Training SJ @ Duchy College 2nd Feb cost £25. Has someone sent out the booking form to our members?

**New Vac rules** state that horses now HAVE to have had a vaccination in the 6 months and 21 days PRIOR to a qualifier or championships. This sounds complicated, but think of it as 6 months. The 21 days is then a 'grace period' which if you've overlooked it, gives you time to put it right without being disqualified - so if you only compete in summer competitions it would be possible just to have an annual booster in March or April. This comes in on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

**Next qual is 16<sup>th</sup> Feb: Senior 80 & 90 SJ, 100 & 110 mixed** (Senior & Junior). New rules mean that horses may now take part at more than one SJ qualifier at consecutive heights (so 80 & 90 cm = yes, 80 & 100 = no). Eligibility criteria must be met for each section entered. Those competing in the 70cm section cannot compete at another level. Competition format has changed so that the second round is now run as a two phase competition with the jump off included in the course, so that horses taking part in more than one section aren't over jumped.
