The competition pass

Previously, entries to Area Qualifiers have comprised of two payments; a preliminary entry fee paid to Head Office and a local entry fee paid to the venue running the event.

The pre-entry fee paid to Head Office generates income for BRC which covers the costs of scoring materials and rosettes for qualifiers, official steward training, hat tags, and various other training and championships. The local entry fee paid to the venue covers the usual costs of running an event.

From October 2025, pre-entry fees will be replaced by a competition pass.

The competition pass...

- is an annual pass, valid from date of purchase for 12 months,
- covers the pre-entry fees for as many classes at Area Qualifiers as the rider wishes to enter. The local entry fee has to be paid for each event in addition to this,
- is only valid when accompanied by an active Riding Club membership. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they have an up-to-date membership and competition pass when they enter an Area Qualifier,
- covers a member to compete with multiple Riding Clubs. Separate passes do not need to be purchased if a rider wishes to compete for more than one Club,
- can be purchased on Sport 80 and costs £30 plus transaction fee for riders with 1-2 horses, and £45 plus transaction fee for riders with 3 or more horses for a rolling 12 months. Horses' names do not need to be registered.
- only needs to be purchased if a rider wishes to enter an Area Qualifier. Riders who do not want to enter an Area Qualifier do not need to purchase a competition pass.
